#### BREA COMMUNICATIONS SIT-A-LONG PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Brea Police Department makes every effort to create partnerships with members of our communities so that we may work together to make Brea safe and enjoyable places to live and work. The Sit-A-Long Program exists to try to accomplish that goal. The program allows interested members of our community the opportunity to sit with one of our Dispatch Seniors or Communication Training Officers during a portion of his or her regular duty.

Under these conditions the safety of the person sitting is our primary concern. In order to provide optimum safety to Sit-A-Long participants, the following rules and guidelines are in place:

- 1. Community members requesting a sit-a-long should be residents of, or work in, the City of Brea, applicants for employment at the Brea Police Department; recruits currently enrolled in a dispatch academy; or members of the Brea Police Citizen Academy.
- 2. Sit-A-Long participants age 16 and over may sit for two hours, from 1000-2200 hours.
- 3. All appropriate forms (Application, Waiver Consent) from must be signed by the participant (and parent or guardian if a minor) prior to the Sit-A-Long.
- 4. Upon receipt of a Sit-A-Long Application, a criminal record check will be completed on the applicant through the California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System. Where it is not in the best interests of the applicant or the department, the application to sit-a-long will be denied.
- 5. The program coordinator will set the day and time of the sit-a-long after receipt of the application. Every effort will be made to schedule a sit-a-long at the requested day and time.
- 6. Cameras and recording equipment may not be brought in or used during the sit-a-long.
- 7. Participants may be exposed to privileged and confidential information and must agree not to discuss such information with anyone.
- 8. Unless authorized to do so, participants shall not review any official report or record of the Brea Police Department.
- While conducting the sit-a-long, participants will not leave the dispatch center and safety
  of dispatch unless otherwise directed by the Senior Dispatcher or Communications
  Training Officer. Participants must obey the directives of the Dispatch Senior or
  Communications Training Officer at all times.
- 10. It is important to us that we maintain a neat and orderly image so we may ask the participant to wear appropriate attire.
- 11. Because of the popularity of this program, we must limit the number of times one can sitalong to no more than once every six months, and only if it does not interfere with first-time-riders.
- 12. Deviations to these guidelines may be made with specific permission of the on-duty Communications Supervisor, Senior Dispatcher, or Watch Commander.

The Sit-A-Long program is intended to be an informative and educational experience, and it is certainly our privilege to provide this opportunity to those who are interested. It is another important way of providing a needed channel of communication between members of our community and members of the Brea Police Department.
